Audition Instructions

All initial auditions will be self-recorded and sent remotely. Please record your own audition, then upload the video or clips to YouTube or Vimeo (you can make it Unlisted if you don't want the public to view it), and send the video link(s) to the casting director Sky Tallone at: NightSkySF@gmail.com

- Do not try to record yourself selfie-style. Use a tripod, or have someone record you.
- Try to choose a well lit area without too many hard shadows.
- Relax and be vourself!
- Dress the part. Try to wear clothes that go with the type of character you're reading for.

Since there is no dialogue, auditioners will be asked to simply be themselves and answer a few questions to give us an idea of your vibe, look, personality, and energy. Each answer should be 30-90 seconds long.

1. Head and Shoulders Shot: Please introduce yourself with your name, tell us whether or not you're over 18, where you live, and your phone number. Then turn to your left, and to your right, to give us profile views of each side.

For the following questions, please change the camera angle to a wide view so we can see you from head to toe, and face camera.

- 3. Tell us about a positive camping or outdoor experience you've had.
- 4. Tell us about any other outdoor activities you might enjoy, like hiking, climbing, kayaking, etc.
- 5. List any days or times that you are not available to shoot. Are you available on 8/31?
